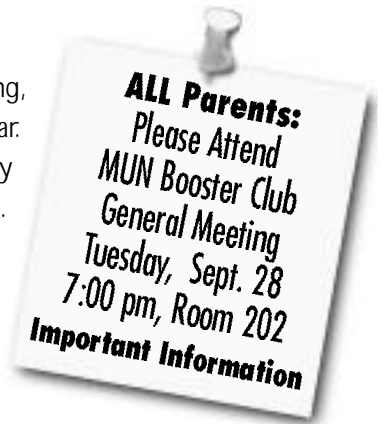
**Welcome Back From Our President**

## Learn About Your Child's MUN Student Account

Each student has an individual Student Account. Deposits are made when a student "earns" money at a fund raising event. Currently there are two events for adding to the student account. The first is the Hometown Fair. The second is the Poinsettia Sale. Money earned by the student is credited to their account. The student is able to access this credit towards the cost of a MUN event such as an away trip or the senior banquet. This student account fund is an individual account and may only be used for MUN costs. All money raised at the MUN fundraisers must remain the property of MUN and can only be used for MUN activities.

MUN Booster Club is a 501(c) 3 organization (non-profit) and under the terms of that designation no money will be issued as a refund check. Student accounts will carry over from

year to year, carry over to siblings in MUN, or return to the MUN General Fund if not used.

Money raised from fundraising is handled in two ways. Some events will directly benefit the participating students and parents. At these events students earn 80% of the net profit for their individual student accounts. The General Fund will receive the remaining 20%. This 80/20 split is a requirement of the school and state education code. The other type of fundraising will directly profit the MUN General Fund. The General Fund is used for travel scholarships, local conference fees, and miscellaneous MUN expense.

Student Account money is managed by the Financial Vice President, Lori Burns (374-7868) and Treasurer, Susan Heisler (546-5394).
